PARENT CLUB MEMBERS PARTICIPATION OBLIGATIONS

As a member of the Westside Gymnastics Parents Club, you and your gymnast receive the benefits of the Club’s fundraising activities. In return, you are obligated to participate in these fundraisers. The board has selected fundraising activities to maximize our ability to raise money without unduly burdening the parent club members. This document briefly summarizes this year’s fundraisers and your obligations. Please sign and return the bottom portion as acknowledgement of your commitment.

1. **Tastefully Simple:** Our first fundraiser of the year. This is a new one and we will be providing incentives (gift cards to yet to be named establishments) for the top sellers. We strongly encourage every family to participate. There is a suggested \$20 buyout for those who do not wish to participate.
2. **See’s Candy:** We will have two See’s Candy sales—one during the winter and one in the spring. Families are expected to participate in both candy sales. Packets will be distributed in the girls’ boxes in advance of the sale. Each family is expected to raise \$25 through each candy sale. Those who do not must donate \$25 to the Club.
3. **Scrip:** We will be selling scrip cards throughout the year. There are scrip cards available for many of the stores and services we use everyday. We strongly encourage each family to participate. There will be incentives for the top participants.
4. **Corporate Sponsors:** We are seeking sponsorships from local business, who in return will receive space in our meet programs and on our website. Each family is required to approach two businesses of their choice. We will provide a letter and all the information you need.
5. **Home Meets:** We will be hosting TWO home meets this year. One on November 6-7 and one April 9-10. The home meets are our biggest fundraiser and to assure their success everyone must participate. For each meet, each family is required to work either a set up or teardown shift. In addition, each family must work **two** sessions (jobs include score keeping, concessions, admissions etc.) per meet. These are adult positions. Gymnast participation as a score flasher does not fulfill the obligation. Failure to show up for any shift, including set up and teardown, will result in your account being billed \$75 per shift not completed.

PARENT AGREEMENT

I/WE understand our obligation to participate in the Westside Gymnastics Parents Club. I/We agree that I/We will participate in See’s Candy sales, or elect to contribute \$25 in lieu of participation. I/We also agree to seek at least two corporate sponsors. Finally, I/WE agree to work the required shifts in support of both the home meets and understand that failure to do so will result in a charge of \$75 per shift to our Parent Club Account.
